

## **Seth Rosenbloom**

Guitarist Seth Rosenbloom was born into a musical family in Waltham, Massachusetts. After playing violin in his earliest years, raised on a backdrop of Mozart and Beethoven, he took up guitar at age eleven, originally influenced by Elvis Presley and The Beatles. At the young age of sixteen, Seth was accepted with merit scholarship to the prestigious Berklee College of Music. A dean's list student at Berklee, Seth developed his composition and technical chops in both jazz and improvisational music, expanding his musical vocabulary.

After spending his first 23 years in Boston, Seth moved to the Raleigh - Durham area of North Carolina in 2016. In addition to performing and teaching in the Triangle area, Seth has been a featured performer at major music industry events including the annual Guitar Summit in Durham, most recently hosted at the Millennium Hotel Durham in 2016. Seth has taught and performed at multiple events at the Raleigh Music Academy, alongside renowned guitarists including Ron 'Bumblefoot' Thal and Andy Timmons. He has also been asked to demonstrate for guitar and amplifier companies at industry trade shows on multiple occasions, including NAMM and SEGAS.

With a sound rooted in the blues, Seth draws on many classic influences including Stevie Ray Vaughan, BB King, and Jimi Hendrix, as well as more contemporary guitarists such as Eric Gales, Joe Bonamassa and Derek Trucks. What sets Seth apart, however, is the heavy-hitting attitude which he brings to every performance. Always improvising, the sultry lines and tone Seth creates never fail to inspire his audiences and draw in those who hear him.
